

1.1.1 - Protecting your private information is our priority. By using the ImmortalNode website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

1.1.2 -TRUSTe Privacy Program ImmortalNode is a licensee of the TRUSTe Privacy Program. 1.1.5 - Collection of your Personal Information ImmortalNode may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. If you purchase ImmortalNode's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

1.1.6 - Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by ImmortalNode. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the ImmortalNode website.

2.0.1 - ImmortalNode encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from ImmortalNode so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. 2.1.2 - Use of your Personal Information ImmortalNode collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

2.1.3 - ImmortalNode may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from ImmortalNode and its affiliates. ImmortalNode may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

2.1.4 - ImmortalNode does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

2.1.5 - ImmortalNode may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to ImmortalNode, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

3.1.1 - Use of Cookies The ImmortalNode website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run

3.1.2 - One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page.
